Job Title: Director of High School Youth

General Summary

The Director of High School Youth (the Director) is a full-time, non-ordained position responsible for nurturing the Christian faith of Covenant high school youth through healthy, supportive and challenging relationships, and through the development and implementation of Christian-based activities and programs.

Responsibilities

The Director is responsible for the overall coordination and administration of the Covenant high school youth programs and will work in close partnership with adult church leaders, volunteers, the Director of Middle School Youth and the Associate Minister of Christian Education and Spiritual Formation. More specifically, the Director's responsibilities are to:

- Help determine vision and plans for high school youth programs which include spiritual disciplines that encourage a personal relationship with Jesus Christ
- Build one-on-one relationships with the high school students, establishing trust, and nurturing their faith
- Help support, nurture and minister to the high school youth's families
- Grow in participation of youth programs
- Provide leadership, build relationships, conduct training, and offer spiritual support to adult leaders and volunteers
- Plan, prepare and lead mission trips, Youth Sunday, Senior Sunday and other events
- Coordinate curriculum selection, and actively participate in on-going programs for Sunday school, youth fellowship and Covenant Connection
- Develop and coordinate weekday and weekend activities in alignment with Covenant's vision and values, and attend off-campus youth activities
- Coordinate, plan and help lead high school summer activities
- Coordinate and lead high school bible studies and other small groups
- Attend events of Covenant youth, as feasible, such as recitals, sporting events, plays, etc.
- Help integrate new Covenant families with high school youth
- Assist high school youth with their transition into college years
- Handle all administrative duties as appropriate (phone calls, emails, social media, meetings, written communication, etc.)
- Encourage and provide opportunities for youth participation in worship
- Provide leadership development opportunities for youth
- Serve as a thought leader and key member of the Education Ministry leadership team
- Must strictly abide by and enforce Covenant's Child Protection Policy

It is not intended that these enumerated responsibilities include all details of the functions inherent in this position, nor does it give exclusive title to every function described. The position incumbent will perform other duties as required or directed, or as warranted by specific situations.

- Basic working knowledge of Microsoft Office products desired
- Financial literacy and budgeting experience desired
