



Summer Internship in Christian Discipleship

Covenant Presbyterian Church seeks a summer intern who wishes to learn about and engage in the ministry of Christian discipleship in the context of a large, urban Presbyterian congregation.

Covenant Presbyterian is a dynamic Christian community that gladly invites all people into a transformational experience of faith; boldly proclaims the gospel, bravely works toward a whole and just world and passionately nurtures discipleship.

The summer intern for Christian discipleship will enjoy a broad range of experiences in ministry, and should be committed to growing in a life of Christian faith and interested in exploring how to help children, youth, and adults grow in their journeys of faith.

Internship Expectations

- Begin the summer internship on May 30, conclude the summer internship no earlier than August 11; 40 hours a week working Sundays – Thursdays.
- Work with current Ministry of Education staff covering teaching, curriculum development, service opportunities and relational ministry with children, youth and families.
- Share in leading adult classes, Bible studies, and other programs as needed.
- Assist with liturgy and leading worship and preach one time.
- Assist with preparation and execution of Vacation Bible School for preschool and elementary children (August 7-11).
- Travel with the youth for at least one mission experience as determined by Ministry of Education staff.
- Be an ambassador of Covenant Presbyterian Church both among its members and in the greater world, seeking to follow in the way of Christ and demonstrate love, kindness, generosity, and care to all.
- Meet as needed with the Associate Minister of Pastoral Care to reflect on ministry experiences and seek assistance or resources as needed. Collaborate regularly with Director of Middle School Youth Ministries regarding summer programming.

Internship Compensation and Benefits

- \$4200 stipend paid in three equal payments throughout the summer.
- Access to the Covenant Presbyterian Church Recreation Center.
- Travel and food costs associated with mission trips and/or retreats.
- Books and other resources needed for weekly reflection.
