AN UPDATE ON CAMPUS CONSTRUCTION

Covenant's *For a Whole Community* capital campaign supports investments in early childhood education, affordable housing and campus improvements. Here's an update:

- **Campus construction:** Site work continues with clearing and site preparation. Shelco is working with Piedmont Natural Gas to relocate a gas line discovered to be located in the area of the new building. Shelco also is working with Duke Energy to secure power to the site. Site work will continue for the next couple of weeks when, weather permitting, foundation work will begin.
